This is a defensive course series for America's favorite rifle, the AR-15. - In this course, Instructor, Tom Oakes will cover the basics of defensive rifle. Students are expected to come to class with an intermediate level of experience and knowledge of the AR-15.

Prerequisite: Successful completion of NRA PPOH course or equivalent holstered handgun competency evidenced by certification from a recognized firearms training academy (subject to approval).

What to bring: AR-15 Iron sights or Eotech/Aimpoint or similar optics, sling (single point recommended) -Handgun semiautomatic with two magazines (three recommended) - Strong side outside the waistband holster (no Cordura nylon), or tactical thigh holster and a gun belt - Tactical vest/sneaky bag/dump pouch whatever you are going to use to hold your AR and pistol mags - Ammunition (TBD) - Eye and hearing protection - Layered clothing appropriate for the weather - Baseball cap, visor, brimmed hat - Closed toe, non-skid, sport shoes or tactical boots, kneepads optional.
