Advanced Defensive Pistol Techniques Clinic August 5 • \$150

All shooting is done from strong side, outside the waist band hip or thigh holster. Focus is on safety and

defensive accuracy. Student to Instructor ratio is 1:1 for all advanced moving and reactive target engagement. This is a full day of shooting out of the holster. This is not an NRA certified course.

<u>Prerequisite:</u> Successful completion of NRA PPOH course or equivalent holstered handgun competency evidenced by certification from a recognized firearms training academy (subject to approval).

<u>Bring to class:</u> Handgun- Revolver or semiautomatic • Strong side outside the waistband holster (no Cordura nylon) • Two magazine or speedloader pouches and a gun belt • Three magazines or two speedloaders • Ammunition (200 rounds/100 rounds frangible for steel targets) • Eye and hearing protection • Front opening jacket • Baseball cap or visor • Closed toe, non-skid, sport shoes or tactical boots, kneepads optional.

Men & Women's Pistol II Class July 18, 2012 5pm • Cost \$10

\$10.00 for women who have completed the beginner handgun class, or women who have had similar shooting experience (call for information). This class picks up where the beginner class left off. Bring your own pistol and ammunition or use a "class" 9mm or .40 caliber automatic. Learn how different models operate. Learn how to clean a gun. Practice shooting a little faster and at farther ranges.

Men & Women's PISTOL III CLASS August 15, 2012 5pm • Cost \$10

\$10.00 For women who have completed the Pistol II Class or women who have had similar shooting experience. The Pistol III class picks up where the pistol II class left off. You MUST bring your own pistol, ammunition and holster. Learn how to draw a pistol from a holster. We will be dry practicing the 5 point draw stroke. Learn how to perform a tactical reload, a speed re-load, and malfunction clearing drills
