

Summer Doubles League Frequently Asked Questions (F.A. Q.)

Q: How many weeks do we shoot in the league?

A: We will be shooting a total of 6 weeks on Sundays. We will shoot on the following days: 7/12, 7/19, 7/26, 8/2, 8/9 and 8/16.

Q: How much does it cost to shoot?

A: Each shoot is \$20.00 for adults 18 years and over. To encourage our junior shooters, the shoot fee will be waived and junior shooters only need their gun and shotshells to participate.

Q: I do not want to shoot the league, can I still come out on a Sunday and shoot doubles?

A: The purpose of the league is to present a well organized and committed shooting event at the trap venue. We will never discourage participation of any shooter but the league will always give squadding preference to the league participants and the shoot fee of \$20 will apply during the league shoot times.

Q: It's summer and shooters go on vacation. What if I cannot make all 6 shoots?

A: We know that summers mean vacations and sometimes you have to miss a shoot. The league committee will allow makeups for missed shoots under the following conditions*:

Weeks 1-5: makeup must be shot by the 5th Sunday, 8/2/15 Week 6: no makeups on the last shoot.

If you know that you are going to miss a shoot, you may also shoot ahead for that week. Be prepared to pay the league shoot fee when you shoot the makeup.

Q: Will there be an Awards Lunch this year?

A: Yes, lunch and awards presentation will be held on 8/16/2015 after the last shoot is complete. Registered league shooters who complete all 6 shoots are eligible for the lunch and awards.

Q: Can I bring my family to the Awards Lunch?

A: Each shooter is entitled to one guest at the lunch. Additional guests may attend at an additional cost of \$10.00 per guest. We ask that your league coordinators (Gregg, Debbie, John or Alaura) be notified and payment made for any additional guests, by the second to last shoot (8/9/2015) so that proper food and drink amounts are obtained.

Q: Will there be award divisions for the league?

A: For registered league participants, we will have special awards for the following divisions (depending on participation) and each shooter is only eligible for one award:

Mens 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} Ladies 1^{st} , 2^{nd} 3^{rd}

2nd 3rd Juniors 1st, 2nd, 3rd

High Overall (includes mens, ladies, juniors)

Senior High Overall (60+) Most Improved Shooter

In addition, each league participant who completes all 6 shoots, will receive a special participation award.
